There are 5 different stamps that are used in Scott County by the auditors to indicate an acceptable immunization record.

This stamp is required for records that are complete for childcare/preschool setting. The stamp will be located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for records that are complete for Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade school settings with the exception of students in 7<sup>th</sup> grade. \*Exception see stamps below. The stamp will be located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for the \*Tdap law. Starting with the 2013-2014 school year, and all future school years, students entering/advancing/or transferring into 7<sup>th</sup> grade and/or born on or after September 15, 2000 are required to have this stamp located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for the \*Meningococcal (MenACWY) law. Starting with 2017-2018 school year, and all future school years, students entering/advancing/or transferring into 7<sup>th</sup> grade and born after September 15, 2004 are required to have this stamp located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for the Meningococcal (MenACWY) law. Starting with the 2017-2018 school year, and all future school years, students entering/advancing/or transferring into 12<sup>th</sup> grade and born after September 15, 1999 will need proof of two doses of Meningococcal (ACWY) vaccine, or 1 dose if received when student was 16 years of age or older. The required stamp is located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.
