



Has Your Child Had a Lead Test?

Exposure to lead can cause:



Damage to the brain and nervous system



Slowed growth and development



Learning and behavior problems



Hearing and speech problems



Children should have a lead test done at age 12 months and 24 months to catch lead exposure early, which can prevent damage to a child's development. Check with your child's health care provider or the Scott County Health Department where lead tests are free for Scott County children ages 1-6 years old. Call 563-326-8618 to schedule an appointment!
