Who's eligible for Medicaid?

You may be eligible for Medicaid even if you currently have private insurance. Medicaid pays other expenses that your private insurance may not cover.

Medicaid also covers pregnant women up to 375% of the Federal Poverty Level—that's up to \$98,250 a year for a family of four!
