TIPS for making a great partnership with your medical home:

- Bring your child's insurance card
- Bring a copy of your child's immunization record
- Bring a list of medications your child is taking
- Write down your questions and concerns before the appointment
- Bring another adult with you to help you remember what the doctor says
- Relax, ask questions, and take notes
- Follow-up on any advice that the doctor gives for your child
- If you can not make it to an appointment, call the doctor's office the day before the appointment to cancel




Medical Home

HOW does having a medical home benefit my family?


Creating a medical home for your child helps in many ways such as:
