Safety During Flooding



Before flooding

Plug floor drains to keep sewage out M Prepare for the flood's crest.

Seal openings of above-ground systems to keep silt out of the system

During flooding



- Do NOT use your private sewage system; use a large container with a tight fitting lid as a temporary toilet.
- Do NOT drink your well water; it may be contaminated by the flood water. Drink bottled water or disinfect water before drinking.



After flooding

- Read and follow the Septics & Wells handouts on how to inspect your systems and begin clean-up
- Call a professional if:
 - *You get a bad water test from your well
 - *You think your septic tank is damaged
