



Transportation

Care for Kids connects families to transportation to health appointments.

Through the Medicaid health insurance, families are able to get free transportation services to healthcare appointments billed to their child's insurance. Depending upon the child or adolescent's Medicaid insurance plan, the family will call either their Managed Care Organization (MCO) or the Medicaid Fee for Service transportation broker. See below for how to contact the different transportation brokers.

For those signed up with *Medicaid Fee for Service* plans, call the state transportation broker as follows:
