



# Incident Command System and Resource Management for the Fire Service (F0376)

This is a significantly revised two-day program providing students with an understanding of the Incident Command System (ICS) and resource management for the fire service and their application in both emergency and non emergency situations. This course addresses the need for an ICS, and provides an overview of the structure and flexibility of ICS, an understanding of the command skills necessary to function effectively in an ICS structure, and the need to effectively manage your resources. This course meets the requirements of ICS-100 and ICS-200.
