

There are five different stamps used by Scott County Health Department auditors to indicate an immunization record is acceptable.

This stamp is required for records that are complete for childcare/preschool setting. The stamp will be located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for immunization records that are complete for students in kindergarten through 12th grade, with exception for students entering, advancing to, or transferring into 7th grade. *See the stamps for exceptions below. The stamp will be located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for the *Tdap law. Beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, students entering, advancing to, or transferring into 7th grade are required to have one dose of Tdap vaccine. The stamp will be located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for the *Meningococcal (MenACWY) law. Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, students entering, advancing to, or transferring into 7th grade are required to have one dose of Meningococcal vaccine. The stamp will be located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.



This stamp is required for the *Meningococcal (MenACWY) law. Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, students entering, advancing to, or transferring into 12th grade are required to have proof of two doses of the Meningococcal (MenACWY) vaccine, or one dose if the student received the vaccine at 16 years of age or older. The stamp will be located on the right side of the Certificate of Immunization.
