This is the mandatory training session required for all qualified personnel to volunteer to be part of the Iowa BSAFE Disaster Response Team. Training is provided by the Iowa Department of Public Safety – Division of the Fire Marshal through a grant from the Federal Department of Homeland Security. BSAFE Disaster Assistance was developed to provide liability coverage for those qualified building professionals volunteering in response to a natural disaster. Training provides information on FEMA disaster protocols and how to inspect damaged structures following a natural disaster. BSAFE volunteers will not be utilized unless the Iowa Homeland Security Emergency Management Department (IHSEMD) activates the team in response to a declared state of emergency due to a natural disaster. Team members are able to decline to participate at any time so we are seeking to train as many volunteers as possible in order to provide adequate coverage state-wide. **Space is limited** so please register on-line at www.IABO.net by October 31, 2015.
