Individual Assistance Grant Funds for Scott County Residents

A disaster proclamation, signed by Iowa Governor Terry Branstad and released March 8th, allows State resources to be utilized to respond to and recover from the effects of the recent severe weather. Scott County residents affected by the severe weather may be eligible to apply for individual grant assistance to cover losses experienced. To qualify, households must be located within the disaster declaration area, and must meet income guidelines.

The program provides grants up to \$5,000 per household to cover home or car repairs, replacement of clothing or food, and for the expense of temporary housing, if applicable. Original receipts are required for those seeking reimbursement for actual expenses related to storm recovery.

Households must have an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty guideline. Eligibility for the program is based upon federally established income guidelines.
